

A garage specifically for storing specialized airport vehicles.




08 Gymnasium

Aviation Maintenance Department
(3 Years)

Our training facilities are designated specifically for training airmen certified by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, meaning that students can acquire a national qualification while attending school. Students are able to acquire solid knowledge and skills by using real airplanes and engines as training equipment. In partnership with ANA and JAL, there is also a course to train first-class aircraft mechanics. It is our goal to train and bring up workers who can play an active role immediately after joining an airline.

Airport Technology Department
(2 Years)

At our ground handling course, which is the oldest in Japan, we train specialists who support aircraft operations on the ground. We have a large number of specialized airport vehicles for practical training here in Japan. Students undergo practical training which is just like working at an airport on a vast site, and they can acquire 12 types of qualifications during attendance at our school.



Comprehensive Stage

Aim to enter a high-level university through comprehensive study focused on a career in the aviation industry!

In order to meet the diversifying career paths of students in recent years, we focus on subjects necessary for university entrance examinations, in addition to aviation-related subjects, with the aim of consolidating basic academic skills which allows students to advance to universities and affiliated schools.





F Lake Shikotsu
